

FACES OF FRIENDSHIP FRIENDSHIP TERRACE:

HOUSE RULES HIGHLIGHTS

Resident's agree that the following House Rules and any additional reasonable rules and regulations subsequently adopted by Landlord/Owner of which Resident receives reasonable notice shall be part of this lease and shall be incorporated by reference herein. Resident further agrees that any failure by Resident, or failure by others on the property with the consent of resident, to abide fully by such rules and regulations may be deemed by Landlord/Owner as a default by Resident and breach of this lease:

- 24. RESIDENT DRESS. Resident should be properly attired in common areas, as well as in areas open to the public. (Night clothes, robes, etc. are not permitted.)
- 31. HARRASSMENT. The Owner and Management consider sexual harassment in the workplace unacceptable conduct that will not be tolerated. Sexual harassment is defined in the Resident Guidelines. Employees who engage in sexual harassment will be subject to discipline, including discharge. Residents who engage in sexual harassment will be subject to termination of their tenancy.




